Curious George™: Let's Get Curious! Exhibit Interactives

Go bananas at **Curious George™: Let's Get Curious!** at Strong National Museum of Play September 20, 2008 through January 4, 2009. Join the fun at interactive stations as you wander through the neighborhood where Curious George lives with his friend The Man with the Yellow Hat.

Apartment Building: Operate wheels to move George on pulleys from window to window. Climb the fire escape and climb inside to play with color, light, and shadow.

Lobby: Enter the apartment lobby replete with elevator (arriving with a “bing!”) and tenants’ mailboxes, each one opening to reveal fun math, science, engineering or Curious George related objects.

Sidewalk Produce Stand: Fruit is sweet, and math is too! Play customer or salesperson and explore shapes, sorting, weighing, and counting with fruit and vegetables.

Construction Site: Climb into the construction trailer and work at a light table to design a building. Then, get to “work” at the adjacent construction site. Use a bounty of building materials to create different structures and a conveyor system to move materials.

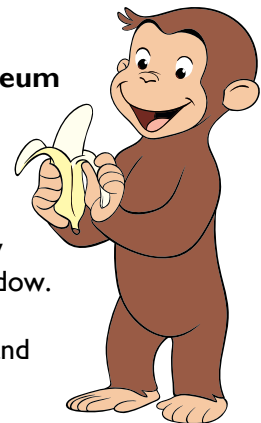
City Park: Come relax on a bench in the urban green space inspired by a city pocket park. Give a hug to a full-size George and take a picture! The youngest visitors will enjoy “busywall” activities for infants and toddlers.

Mini Golf: Putt your way through three miniature golf holes. Manipulate pipes, ramps, funnels, turntables, bumpers and force to experiment with physics and engineering as you putt.

Space Rocket: Climb into the famous rocket Curious George took on his space adventure! Peek into portholes to view scenes from space. Catch a glimpse of George in his space suit, then take a picture from the control station and email it home.

The Farm: Take a trip to the country and visit the farm. Experience cause and effect and use wind power to move yard art like windmills, windsocks, and wind chimes. Build your own whirligig and care for the farm animals.

Museum Within the Museum: Learn new things about George when you visit the Museum Within the Museum. This area features a retrospective of H.A. and Margret Rey’s work; the story of their escape from France to safety during World War II, which saved the Curious George manuscript; and a look at Curious George through the years.
