Abstract: The Coleman family papers are a comprehensive compilation of materials from the professional careers of Dorothy, Evelyn (“Jane”), and Elizabeth (“Ann”) Coleman related to dolls and doll history. (Some personal papers are included in this collection as well.) The bulk of the papers are dated between 1963 and 1996.

Biographical Note

Dorothy E. (Smith) Coleman and her two daughters, Elizabeth (“Ann”) and Evelyn (“Jane”), were self-educated authorities in the world of dolls and doll collecting. Beginning in the 1960s, the trio worked together to research, write, photograph, and publish some of the most respected volumes on antique dolls and doll clothing. Their book credits include *Dolls: Makers and Marks* (1963), *The Age of Dolls* (1965), *The Collector’s Encyclopedia of Dolls, Volume 1* (1968), *The Collector’s Book of Doll Clothes* (1975), and *The Collector’s Encyclopedia of Dolls, Volume 2* (1986). For more than three decades, the Colemans amassed examples, gave lectures, consulted with doll groups, and led international tours to teach participants about dolls and doll history. Artifacts from the legendary “Coleman Collection” of dolls have been used in publications, conference talks, and educational videos.

Ann Coleman is retired from her distinguished career in the museum world (working in the curatorial departments of the Newark Museum, Brooklyn Museum, Museum of Fine Arts in Houston, and the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston). She founded the Costume Society of America in 1974 and has been a long-time member of the United Federation of Doll Clubs (UFDC), the International Council Museum, and the Textile Society of America, among other groups. As of 2023, she continues to serve as a consultant for various organizations and travels around the world.

Collection Scope and Content Note

The Coleman family papers contain draft manuscripts, correspondence, reference materials, notes, photographs, and other materials created or used by Dorothy, Evelyn, and Elizabeth (Ann) Coleman in preparation of their well-known books. These materials include complete copies of draft manuscripts with annotations for *Dolls: Makers and Marks* (1963), *The Age of Dolls* (1965), *The Collector's Encyclopedia of Dolls, Volume 1* (1968), *The Collector's Book of Doll Clothes* (1975), and *The Collector's Encyclopedia of Dolls, Volume 2* (1986). The Colemans' reference files for doll clothes, dollhouses, mechanical toys, and other toys are also contained in this collection. Additionally, there are planning materials for the Colemans' doll videos, doll tours, and consultations. More information can be found in the Contents List section of this finding aid.

The Coleman family papers have been arranged into two series, one of which has been further divided into subseries. The physical materials are housed in 31 archival document boxes, two flat file boxes, and one audiovisual materials box (34 boxes in total). Digital materials are accessible on-site at The Strong.
