Super Rare Games, based in London, England, is a video game distributor and publisher founded in 2018 by George Perkins. Super Rare Games releases limited edition physical versions of games for the Nintendo Switch. The company includes special packaging (collectors editions or SteelBooks) and trading cards with the games. Super Rare Games prints each game only once and limits the number of copies produced.

## Collection Scope and Content Note

---

The Super Rare Games manufacturing proofs consists of box art proofs for SteelBook boxes for the *World of Goo*, *Monster Prom XXL*, *Little Inferno* and *ITTA* Nintendo Switch games.

The collection also contains trading card proofs that include the Super Rare Games logo on the reverse side for *The Sexy Brutale*, *Little Inferno*, *Cactus*, *Octahedron*, *Dog World*, *Metal Unit*, and *Mundaun*. There is a small amount of handwritten notes that document color corrections and changes requested.

The papers are housed in one oversized box in the original order.
