## **Administrative History**

Presage Software, Inc. is a software developer founded in San Rafael, California in 1986. Presage collaborated with many prominent software publishers including Broderbund, The Learning Company, Activision, Interplay, GT Interactive, Sierra Online, and others. The company was acquired by Human Code, Inc. of Austin, Texas in 1999 and became Presage Studios. Human Code was acquired by Sapient in 2000.

In 1993 Presage purchased the rights to the *Lode Runner* series of puzzle-platform games. Its Stepping Stone division developed "edutainment" games including *Chess Mates*. Presage used their proprietary Cross Platform Development System to develop products for DOS, Windows, and Macintosh with shared resources.
