Abstract:	This collection contains material related to the game of checkers, also known as draughts, collected by an enthusiast and competitive player, Alfred C. Darrow, throughout his life. Materials date from 1808 to 2019 with the bulk of materials dating from 1960 to 2010. The collection is comprised of checkers match annotations and analyses, correspondence, manuscripts, newsletters, notes and reference materials, published material, scrapbooks, tournament programs, and more.

Biographical Note

Alfred "Al" Charles Darrow, Jr. was an American checkers enthusiast and tournament player. Darrow was born February 11, 1935, and died April 2, 2020, at the age of 85. He earned a master's degree in mathematics from Kansas University, and worked as a mathematics teacher

and as a software programmer for General Dynamics and Computer Sciences Corporation. Darrow married Margaret "Peggy" Vadas and had a son, Frank.

Darrow played checkers competitively in tournaments, winning several awards including the Connecticut State Championship in 2009. He was a member of the American Checker Federation (ACF) and served as editor of the ACF Bulletin in 2003 and 2004. He was active in the checkers community and had connections to authors and competitive players.

Collection Scope and Content Note

This collection contains material related to the game of checkers, also known as draughts, collected by an enthusiast and competitive player, Alfred C. Darrow, throughout his life. The collection includes Darrow's personal papers as well as material he collected from other sources. The personal material includes awards, correspondence, checkers organization membership documents, notes and reference, photographs, presentations, and analyses of checkers strategies.

Collected materials include clippings, checkers tournament programs, correspondence checkers (play-by-mail) materials, checkers clubs' and organizations' documents, material from Darrow's time in the role of editor of the ACF Bulletin, published materials, and unpublished manuscripts. Materials from other checkers players and authors, including Ben Boland and Richard L. Fortman, are also represented in the collection.

The collection dates from 1808 to 2019, with the bulk of materials dating from 1960 to 2010. The materials are housed in 10 record cartons, 19 letter document boxes, 7 legal document boxes, and 7 oversize flat boxes. The contents have been arranged into eight series with Series I and Series VI further divided into two sub-series. For more information on series and sub-series, see each series' Scope and Content Notes.

Some correspondents of note include: Ben Boland, author of many books on checkers strategy; Richard L. Fortman, champion checkers player and author; Don "Mr. Checkers" Deweber, owner of the World Checker Museum and the Caldwell-Windt Library of Checkers (now part of the Loras College Rare Book Library in Dubuque, Iowa); former American Checker Federation presidents Lester Balderson (1986-2003) and Alan Millhone (2003-2023); and Charles Walker, president of the International Checker Hall of Fame.

Of interest in Box 2 Folder 14 is a copy of *Wiswell v. Fraser, Free Style World Championship* (1959-1961) sent to Alfred Darrow personally by eminent author and checkers player Tommie Wiswell.

Series IV: Checkers organizations, 1915-2018

Series Scope and Content Note

This series contains administrative documents and printed material pertaining to checkers organizations which Alfred Darrow was involved or interested in. Organizations represented in this series include the American Checker Federation (ACF), English Draughts Association, the International Checker Hall of Fame (ICHF), regional checkers organizations in the United States and Canada, and more. The materials are arranged alphabetically by organization.

The American Checker Association (ACA), founded in 1906, and the National Checker Association (NCA) merged on Sept 1st, 1947 using the NCA as a temporary name with 665 membership. The new name of the American Checker Federation (ACF) was chosen by full vote on May 1st 1948.

The English Draughts Association (EDA) was formed in 1898 to promote the game of Draughts in the British region of the world, including members from England, Scotland, Wales, Republic of Ireland, Australia, Russia, Czech Republic, Northern Ireland, USA and Denmark. The EDA runs many events including the English Open and the British Open on alternative years.

Charles C. Walker opened the International Checker Hall of Fame (ICHF) in Petal, Mississippi in May 1979. The complex included a museum, library, hall of flags, gift shop, tournament rooms, and condominiums/efficiency apartments for retired checker players. Many local and national tournaments were held at the ICHF. In December 2006, Ron "Suki" King of Barbados defeated Jim Morrison of Kentucky to defend his World GAYP Title (3-0 and 18 draws). On September 29, 2007 a fire started in the tower and quickly engulfed the hall and the rest of the checker complex, destroying all of ICHF.

Series Scope and Content Note

This series contains materials from and about checkers tournaments, including American, international, and correspondence checkers. Countries represented in the international tournaments include Australia, Barbados, Canada, England, Germany, Ireland, Scotland, and The United States. The materials are arranged alphabetically by organization or tournament title. Individual matches and correspondence tournaments are arranged separately at the end of the series.

In tournament checkers the preferred variation is three-move restriction, where the first three moves are drawn at random from a set of accepted openings. Two games are played with the chosen opening, each player having a turn at either side. This variation has been play in United States championships since 1934. A two-move restriction was used from 1900 until 1934 in the United States and in the British Isles until the 1950s.

Before 1900, championships were played without restriction: this style is called go-as-you-please (GAYP). Checkers clubs and organizations will sometimes host GAYP style tournaments in addition to the restricted tournaments.

Correspondence checkers is a version of checkers that allows players in different locations to take turns over time using methods such as postal mail or online communication.

Series Scope and Contents

This series consists of clippings and scrapbooks pertaining to checkers. Some of the scrapbooks were compiled by Alfred Darrow and some belonged to other collectors and were later collected by Darrow. The majority of material is in English with some instances of Dutch, Italian, Portuguese, and Russian. The materials are physically arranged by size and format.

Checkers columns in newspaper have a history dating back to the early 19th century. Columns evolved from early individual publications to dedicated sections in major publications, often appearing alongside chess columns. Prominent checkers columnists include George F. Wales and Rex B. Wood. *The New York Clipper* (also known as *The Clipper*), a weekly entertainment newspaper published in New York City from 1853 to 1924, featured a chess and draughts (checkers) column.

Some items may be inaccessible due to the fragility of materials. Items that may be affected are noted as fragile in the finding aid. For access to fragile materials, contact the archivist.
